RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. The tournament will be open to Singaporeans and PR in the age categories Under 21 Category.
- 2. S league and Prime league players are not allowed to participate in this tournament.
- 3. Each team consists of a maximum of 10 players. A team must register a team manager, who has to be registered as a player if he wants to play.
- 4. The tournament will be organised on 16,17 Nov 2019 at <u>Teen Challenge Ground 735 Old Choa Chu Kang Rd, Singapore 699798.</u>
- 5. Tournament entry fees is **\$200 per team.**
- Closing date for the tournament registration is 31 Oct 2019. Teams should submit the
 completed Registration forms, indemnity forms to Teen Challenge Singapore before the
 closing date.
 - Registration location is at 735 Old Choa Chu Kang Rd, Singapore 699798.
- 7. It is compulsory for the Team Manager or Team Captain to attend the briefing before the start of the games. For U21 category, the briefing will be at 4:30pm at 9 Nov 2019 at Jurong West Stadium.
- Rolling Trophy will be awarded to the winner and it will be kept in Teen Challenge showcase. Medals will be awarded players of the top 3 teams.
 Prize monies will be \$1000 for Winners, \$500 for Runners up and \$250 for 2nd Runners up. No medals will be given for the 4th placed team.
 Cheques will be given out during the prize giving ceremony.
- 9. The team that wins the Teen Challenge-Acestes Cup tournament for 3 consecutive years will be able to bring back the Rolling Trophy permanently.
- 10. The players must bring along their Identity Card for verification purposes before going to the pitch on match day.
- 11. In case a player does not fulfil the criteria, he can be excluded from the tournament immediately.
- 12. In case of adverse weather conditions (lightning and heavy rain) the tournament shall be stopped for the safety of all participants. The tournament will resume only when Teen Challenge ground staff gives the go-ahead.
- 13. Tournament shall be postponed in case of adverse weather conditions prevailing throughout the day. In case postponement of the tournament after few games, the results shall be carried forward to a new date arranged by the tournament organizers.
- 14. Players and or team supporters who behave aggressively, use vulgarities or racist remarks on officials or other participants on or off the pitch will be asked to leave the premises and will be handed over to the police. The Organizing committee reserves the right to take all necessary action to protect its officials, players and supporters.
- Any player or team supporters caught vandalizing or defacing properties in or around Teen Challenge will be referred to the authorities.









- Smoking is strictly prohibited in the Teen Challenge premises. NEA officers will be at the premises to enforce the prohibition.
- 17. Alcohol consumption is strictly prohibited during the tournament.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- 1. Teams will play 7 a-side (1 goalkeeper, 6 field players).
- 2. Eight groups of 4 teams will play a round-robin. 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw, 0 for a loss. The top two teams from each group will go forward to the next round of 16 which will be played on a knock —out basis followed by the quarter finals and the semi-finals. The winners from each of the two semi-finals will play the final.
- 3. During the round robin stage, the duration of play will be 14 minutes per game, played in one session without any half-time break (7 mins per half). No extra time will be played.
- 4. In the event of one or more teams being level on points at the end of the round-robin stage, the team with the best result of the direct games will be placed ahead of the others (first number points, followed by better goal difference, followed by the higher numbers of goals scored in the direct match up). Following that, difference of total number of goals scored, followed by higher number of goals scored, number of wins, number of draws. If still teams cannot be separated, a penalty shoot-out will be staged.
- 5. During the knock-out stage, the duration of play will be 10 minutes per game, played in one session without any half-time break.
- 6. A draw after full-time for all games will be decided by penalty shoot-out only during knock-out stage which starts from the second round onwards.
- 7. The format for penalty shoot-out starts with 3 kicks from the penalty spot taken alternately by 3 different players of each team to decide the winner. If at the end of 3 penalty kicks the draw still exists, the winner shall be decided based on "sudden death" i.e. the kicks shall continue until such time one team wins, starting with the players who have not taken a Penalty in the first stage and continuing in the same order as before.
- 8. The tournament shall be governed by the tournament rules and regulations and shall be played in accordance with *FIFA* laws of game, with the exception of there being no off-side law and unlimited / rolling substitutions (registered players only) throughout the matches.
- 9. In order to start a game, each team must have at least 5 players on the field of play. If a Team has insufficient players 5 minutes before start of play is due to commence, the other team will receive 3 points for a win and 3 goals awarded and a walk over will be given.
- 10. Players are *not* allowed to play barefooted or bare-bodied. Each team must have their own jerseys, in the *same colour* (ideally numbered) and players must wear *shin guards* in all matches.
- 11. There will be *no* offside rules.
- 12. FAS Referees will officiate the tournament and their decision are final.
- 13. If a player continues to receive 2 yellow-cards in subsequence matches he will be banned for the third match.









- 14. If a player receives a double yellow card in a match he will be banned for the following match.
- 15. If a player receives a straight red card he will be banned from the tournament.
- 16. In case of any disputes, the decisions by the Organizing Committee are final.
- 17. In case of an appeal, a fee of \$50 has to be paid before the appeal is made. Only the captain of the team and the referee shall approach the committee in case of an appeal.

The organizers have the right to amend the format of the tournament. Please note that the event organizers do not accept any liability for injury caused during the event or losses of things.
